The first step

"The vision of Operating Room Nurses from Austria, France, Germany, Ireland, Switzerland, Sweden, and the United Kingdom conceived the development of a European Operating Room Nurses Association.

At the 2nd World Conference of Operating Room Nurses in 1980, in Lausanne, Switzerland, many nurses from different European countries met to discuss the possibilities of meeting and exchanging ideas relevant to perioperative nursing in Europe. Obviously, working as a perioperative nurse caused similar problems all over the Europe!

The first meeting of the informal European group was held in Brighton in 1981. The initial challenge for this group was to organise the first European day for operating room nurses in connection with the 1982 Annual Congress of the National Association of Theatre Nurses (NATN).





The next step

In 1990 in Mannheim, the group decided on the following five points to make its work more organized:

- only two persons can represent their national association at one meeting.
- the representatives should be the same persons as long as possible.
- one of the representatives should attend the meetings for at least two years.
- a summary of a meeting should be sent to all the countries as soon as possible.
- the topics of the next meeting should be circulated.





The Born of EORNA

In 1991, the National association of theatre nurses began to produce European Newsletters to be circulated all over Europe. At that time, there were 16 member countries in the European group.

The meeting held in Copenhagen in April 1992 was a crucial one. There were 17 countries present, and they all wanted to formalize the European group in 17 different ways. There were several suggestions for the group's official name, and the representatives chose the proposal "European Operating Room Nurses Association".

EORNA was born!

- Education improves the impact of our association through key activities and meetings. Develop and sustain a high degree of education amongst all member countries






EORNA objectives

- The official language is English.




